HOW MANY STUDENTS DO WE TAKE EACH SEPTEMBER? – Grade's 1, 3, 8 and 10 are our intake years, all of the other grades we only replace students that do not return.

Interview Appointment – If space in the appropriate grade is available, one of the secretaries at the school will call to arrange a time for your interview. Typically, we start interviewing in March.

Portfolio Review/Audition – Students in Grades 9-12 complete a portfolio (Visual Arts) or an audition (Performing Arts). These are only done after the interview, you do not need to submit a portfolio with the application.

Grades 1-5 - Students study in the 4 fine arts areas, concentrating a total of 360 minutes per week in the fine arts, 90 minutes in each of the 4 areas. This results in an accelerated pace of learning in language arts, sciences, social studies and mathematics and personal planning.

Grades 6-7 - Students study 3 of the fine arts areas, concentrating a total of 210 minutes per week, 42 minutes per day in each of the 3 areas. The accelerated pace continues in the core academic areas.

Grade 8 - Students choose 2 of the 4 fine arts areas as their "fine arts major" for 6 hours per week, a total of 12 hours for grade 8. Academic courses are semestered, with an accelerated pace in 90 total hours of learning per course.

Grades 9-10 - Students choose 1 of the 4 fine arts areas as their "fine arts major" for concentration. In this area they study 6 hours per week devoted to their choice of fine arts major. Core academic courses are semestered, 90 hours total.

Grades 11-12 - Students have an expanded choice, with photo and writing majors available also. They choose 1 of these 6 as their major with 8 hours per week in this major and a minimum of 3 hours per week in a additional fine arts elective course. Almost all academic course are semestered, 90 hours total.
