Below is a list of supplies that we would like each student to bring to class on the first day back to school in September. In an attempt to be more environmentally conscientious, we are encouraging the students to reuse any supplies from Grade Four that are still in good working condition.

- 2 1/2 inch Zippered Binder with either a built-in zippered pocket for a Pencil Case or a zippered pencil case with holes for attaching in the binder.
- 20 HB Pencils (sharpened)
- 3 Large White Erasers
- 1 Drytape Whiteout
- 3 Blue Ballpoint Pens
- 3 Red Ballpoint Pens
- 2 Black permanent Sharpies
- 2 Black Ultra-Fine tip Sharpies
- 1 Metric Ruler in cm
- 1 pencil Box
- 1 Box 24 Pencil Crayons (NO dollar store quality)
- 1 Box 25 oil Pastels
- 1 Pack 20 Fine Line Felts (NO dollar store quality)
- 1 Pair Scissors
- 2 Large Glue Sticks (NO dollar store quality)
- 1 Bottle of Liquid Glue
- 2 Quality Pencil Sharpeners (enclosed to catch shavings)
- 2 Dictionaries... one English and one French
- 1 Tissue/Kleenex Box (for classroom communal use) NO tissues with Shea Butter
- 1 Calculator with basic functions (+, -, multiply & divide)
- 2 Pack 200 Sheets Lines Paper (or one 500 pack, which ever you can find)
- 1 Pack 50 Sheets of 1/2 cm/1/4 inch Graph Paper
- 1 Drawstring Cloth Gym Bag
- 1 Pair of Gym Shorts
- 1 Short-Sleeved T-Shirt for Gym
- 1 Pair Running Shoes
- 1 Large Old T-Shirt (for Art)
